

## **OUNCE EQUIVALENTS OF GRAINS IN THE CACFP**

## **EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022**

Effective **July 1, 2022**, ounce equivalents (oz. eq.) will be used as measurements for creditable grains (bread/bread alternate) in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). You will be required to use ounce equivalents as the method of measuring and portioning items in the grains component in the CACFP. This includes the infant meal pattern as well.

We are providing you with the tools necessary to train you on this new federal requirement. Below you will find the links to our training video, updated meal pattern charts, and the USDA resources/charts.
