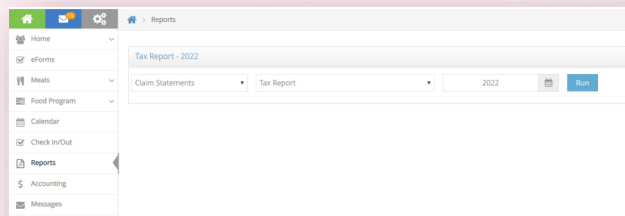

2022 Tax Report

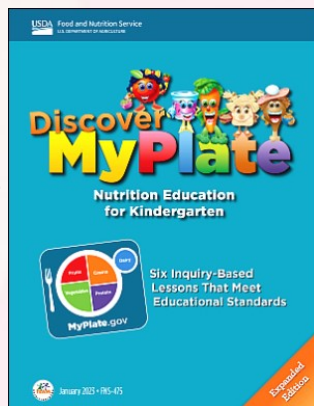
It's that time again! Tax season is upon us. Here are instructions on obtaining your 2022 Tax report:
