Monitoring Visit Procedures for February–September 2026

Our agency has been approved by the State agency to conduct one (1) of the three required monitoring visits virtually for this fiscal year. Unlike last year, all virtual monitoring visits must be unannounced.

One of Your Monitoring Visits Will Be Virtual (Video Call)

For the virtual monitoring visit, providers will be contacted and asked for their preferred method to complete the visit via video call, such as FaceTime, WhatsApp, or Zoom.

During the virtual visit, ECCI will follow the same monitoring requirements and guidelines as an in-person visit. Please refer to the Monitoring Checklist for additional details.

Within 48 hours after the virtual visit is completed, ECCI will email the monitoring report to the provider for electronic signature.

Monitoring Staff Phone Numbers – Important

The following major holidays are **NOT** eligible for meal reimbursement:


